Parade Route: Starts at 3rd & Leary, along 36th St, right on 35th, ends near the Fremont Rocket. Wear sunscreen.

Seattle Art Car Blowout — 75+ decorated cars. Must be seen in person.

Dog Parade — Fremont's best-dressed dogs compete for nothing in particular.
